Pre-Primary Class Requirements 2020

All of the following items are **required for your child to begin the year**. It is very important that all children have the full list of items as described on the booklist in order to start the year. When students have missing, incorrect or non-matching items, learning and teaching can be interrupted. Please ensure that all items are presented on day one and are clearly labelled with your child's name. Spares will be kept in the storeroom to be used by your child when needed.

The following items are to be shared (these items do not need to be labelled):

- 1 packet of 10 Faber-Castel Junior Grip Jumbo Triangle Coloured Pencils (which includes a sharpener in the packet)
- 4 Jumbo Triangle Lead Pencils
- 1 packet of 12 Texta Zoom Roller Crayons
- 2 plastic document wallets
- 1 medium packet of zip lock bags
- 1 roll masking tape 18mm wide
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 cream of tartar
- 4 whiteboard markers – black
- 1 96 page scrapbook

A choice of any TWO of the following:

straws, feathers, patty pans, pipe cleaners, cotton wool balls, balloons

The following items are for personal use:

- 1 St Joseph's School Hat – **labelled with name**
- 1 school bag – **labelled with name**
- 1 library bag – **labelled with name**
- 4 toothbrushes – **labelled with name** (one for each term)
- 1 tube of **children's** toothpaste
- 1 box of tissues

Other items, such as text books or online subscriptions for school and home use, are included in the Amenities Fee collected through the school fees.

Each day your child must bring:

A water bottle – labelled with your child's name

A piece of cut up fruit for crunch and sip/recess

Their lunch.

A spare change of clothes in case of accidents (this should be in your child's bag at all times).

The P & F are responsible for the uniform orders and sales. The Uniform Shop will be open on Thursday January 30th and Friday January 31st from 10am to 1pm.

School starts again for students on Monday 3th February at 8.40am
