In line with the latest State Government and Department of Health advice, current Term 2 arrangements have been reviewed by Catholic Education WA and the following will apply:

Attendance

All students are required to attend school unless they are unwell, have a medical referral to learn from home or live with a family member who is medically vulnerable.

Students who are unwell should stay at home. Parents are asked to seek medical advice if their child exhibits symptoms of COVID-19. Normal processes for advising the school of your child's absence still apply.

Parent and Carers access

Children and parents will still be greeted at the gate on Kintore Street each morning allowing parents to drop children off without having to leave the car. Afternoon pick up arrangements will continue for the immediate future.

Parents and caregivers are allowed onto school grounds to drop off and collect their children. However, parents are not to enter classrooms at the beginning or end of the school day. Parents waiting outside classrooms are reminded to maintain 2m social distancing.

Pre-arranged parent/teacher meetings can be held in classrooms after school, adhering to physical distancing and hygiene protocols.

As assemblies and other school community events are limited to 100 people for indoor settings, we will not have any assemblies for the remainder of term 2.

Remaining Prepared

Catholic schools will continue to review and respond to cleaning and hygiene protocols in line with advice from the Department of Health. In the event of a confirmed case of COVID-19, any temporary school closure will be advised by the Department of Health and the school will enact its CEWA endorsed Response Plan in the event of a confirmed case.

Increased cleaning will continue in Term 2, with cleaning occurring at regular times throughout the school day. We continue to ensure arrangements are in place for regular and thorough hand-washing for students and staff.
