Year 4 Class Requirements 2020

All of the following items are **required for your child to begin the year**. It is very important that all children have the full list of items as described on the booklist in order to start the year. When students have missing, incorrect or non-matching items, learning and teaching can be interrupted. Please ensure that all items are presented on day one and are clearly labelled with your child's name. Spares will be kept in the storeroom to be used by your child when needed. Any labelled, unused equipment will be returned to you at the end of the year.

Please DO NOT label the following items:

- 2 packets of windup crayons
- 2 packets of textas
- 2 packets of coloured pencils
- 2 **wooden** 30cm rulers (3cm wide only)
- 4 erasers
- 12 HB pencils
- 4 red biros
- 6 blue biros
- 2 black Fine Line felt tip pens (0.4mm)
- 2 black permanent markers (no 70)
- 6 glue sticks 35-40gm
- 2 pairs of good sharp scissors
- 4 whiteboard markers – packet (x2)
- 2 large boxes of tissues

Any 2 of the following:

- Sandwich size box of plastic zip-lock bags
- 1 roll of paper towel
- 2 rolls of 18mm masking tape
- Blu tak
- Post it notes
- A4 loose leaf 8mm lined paper pack of 100
- 25ml white pva craft glue

The following items are to be labelled for personal use:

- 1 basic, solar powered calculator
- 2 display books (20 sleeve)
- 2 project books (14mm lined) 48pg
- 2 plastic document wallets (reading folder)
- 4 Scrap books (no larger than 24 x 33 cm)
- 1 set of in-ear (ear bud) headphones
- 2 double hole pencil sharpeners (with catcher)
- 1 St Joseph's School Hat
- 1 school bag
- 1 library bag
- 1 water bottle
- 1 art shirt (old shirt with elasticised sleeves is good)
- 1 empty shoe box – *can be decorated as storage for extra stationery*
- 4 highlighters – packet of different colours

Please DO NOT place items into the pencil case as we are using a 'shared' stationery system. This pencil case is going to be a 'working pencil case' where students can transport essential items like pencils, pens, ruler, eraser etc

Other items, such as text books or online subscriptions for school and home use, are included in the Amenities Fee collected through the school fees.

The P & F are responsible for the uniform orders and sales. The Uniform Shop will be open on Thursday January 30th and Friday January 31st from 10am to 1pm.
