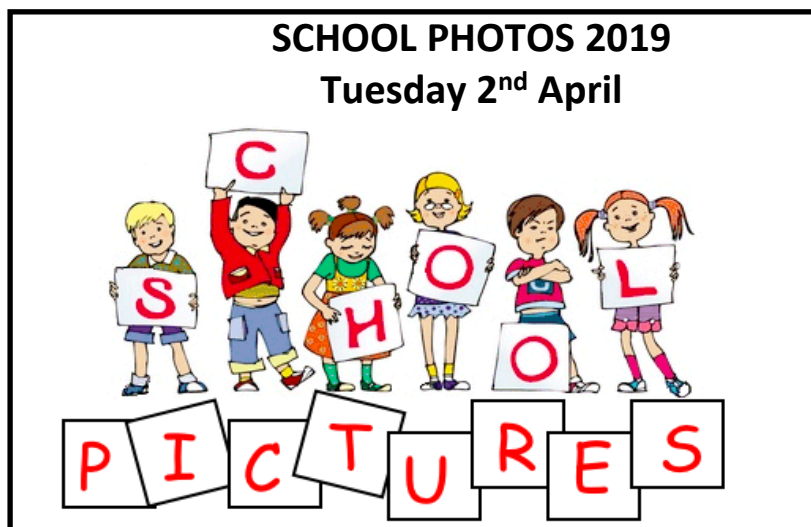

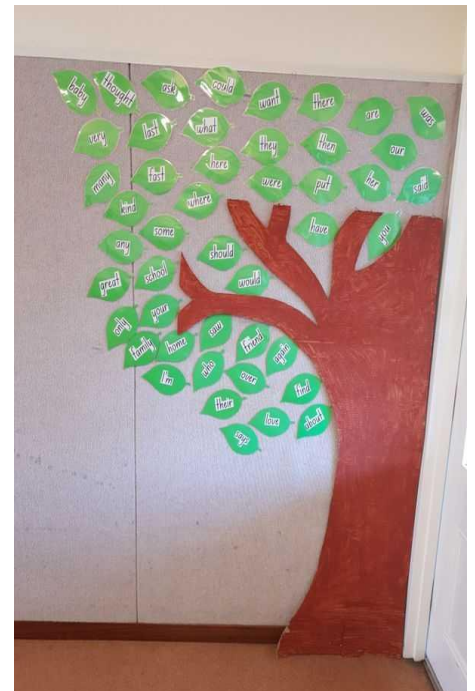
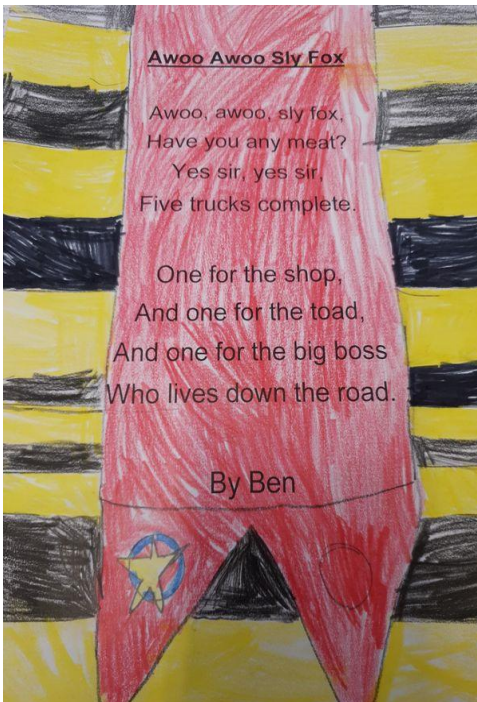


## This Term In Year 2

We have been very busy in Year 2 so far this term. In literacy we have been learning all about adjectives (an adjective describes a noun) and adverbs (an adverb describes a verb) and we used this information to help us to write some poetry. We have also been learning about digraphs (such as 'oi' and 'oy') and trigraphs (such as 'ear' and 'eer') to help us with our spelling and reading. We have also been learning the story 'Room on the Broom' and exploring the rhyming and repetitive structure. Now we are using everything that we have learned so far to write our own narrative story. They seem pretty interesting so far.

In maths we have been learning all about numbers, place value and counting past 100. We have been learning how to count backwards, read and write numbers and number words and also how to use groups of 10 when we are making bigger numbers.

During the afternoons we have been working with the Year 1 class to learn all about 'getting ready to get grubby'. Dirtgirl, Scrapboy and Costa the gnome have all been helping us along the way. We designed and made our own scrapbook covers out of recycled materials so that we have somewhere to store all of the awesome work we will be doing inside and outside the classroom. We have also been looking at different tools, what they are used for and why. We have been comparing the tools we use today with tools that would have been used in the past and discussing the improvements that have been made. We are all ready to go outside and 'get grubby' now so we will be spending some time over the next few weeks outside exploring nature, getting grubby and planting some gardens. We can't wait!



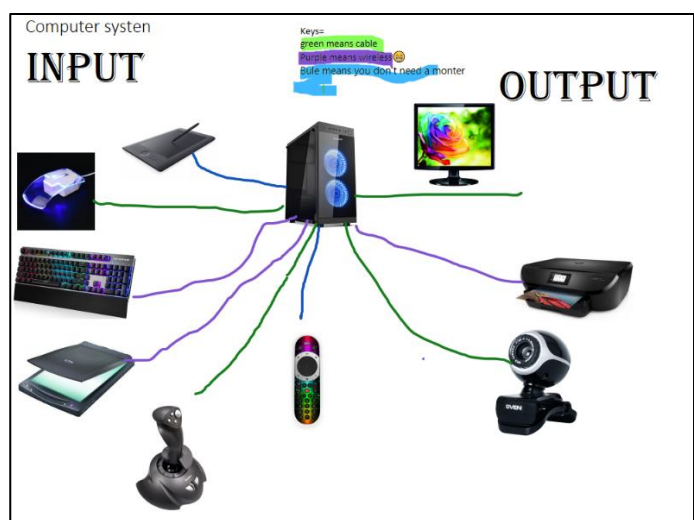
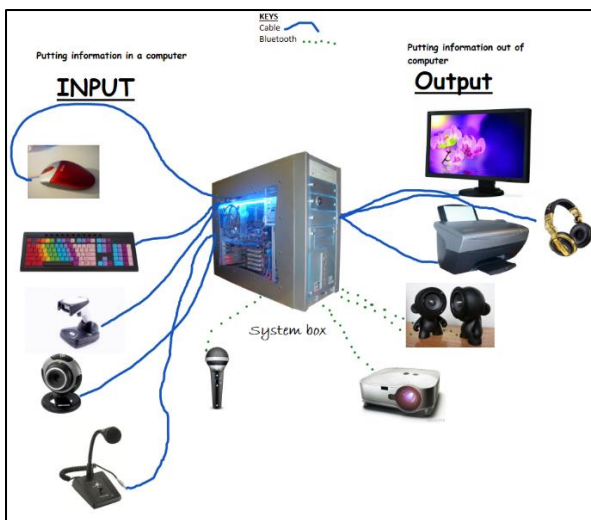


## Digital Technologies News

This term the students have been investigating digital systems with a focus on different types of Peripheral devices that can be attached to a computer system, and whether they are input, output or storage devices. The year 4s have designed their own input devices by creating circuits using the MaKey MaKeys. They made game controllers or keyboards out of Play Doh, lead pencil, foil or bananas attached to the MaKey MaKeys. As you can see from the pictures below, they had a lot of fun experimenting with the different materials.



The year 2s and 5s have been creating presentations on Microsoft Onenote to show what they have learned about digital systems this term, and the year 6s have explored the internal components of a computer and how they work together to process and transmit data.

Year 3 are using the MyMaps app to show the journey of the characters in the book 'Around the World in 80 Days'. They are marking the route and adding pictures and text for each city visited.

Becoming familiar with using the desktop computers and learning basic skills such as logging on and off and accessing programs has been the focus for Year 1. They are also learning the names and uses of the different parts of a computer system.
